Congratulations and Thank You for purchasing tickets to attend Repco Rally Australia.

Owing to the terrain of the Northern Rivers it is recommended that only 2 Special Stages each day be attempted for the purpose of your spectating enjoyment.

If you are planning on viewing the World Rally Championship action on any of the Special Stages that will be conducted across the Northern Rivers, this guide will assist you to plan your Repco Rally Australia experience and maximise your viewing opportunities.

If you are planning on viewing the Super Special stage action at Murwillumbah on either Thursday, Friday or Saturday evenings, please take note of the commencement time and ensure that you have taken up your position in plenty of time to enjoy the action.

Catering for General Admission ticket holders is available on site. Please note that **NO ALCOHOL and NO PETS** are to be taken into the general admission areas of the event.

Spectators must hold either an 'Event Special Stage Pass' or an 'Event Super Pass' to obtain access to the Friday Spectator Points. Friday Special Stage Viewing passes are not sold as individual passes.

Friday Special Stage Spectator Zone Available Special Stage Spectator Points - Morning Session

Special Stage 4 Repco First WRC Car In The Stage At: 08.36

How to get there:
Starting from Summerland Way
1 Head for Geneva Rd
2 Continue on Geneva Rd - go 0.6km
3 Slight right to stay on Geneva Rd - go 1.9km
4 Turn left at Ettrick Rd - go 7.0km
5 Slight left at Iron Pot Creek Rd - go 1.7km
6 Turn right to stay on Iron Pot Creek Rd - go 4.9km

Arriving at Iron Pot Creek Rd
Total: 17.6km - about 32 mins

Comment: Rally cars approach from a narrow road to negotiate a tight left turn with no room for error. Viewing is not restricted by bushland and the point provides good viewing.

Friday Special Stage Spectator Zone Available Special Stage Spectator Points - Morning and Afternoon Session

Special Stage 9 & 10 Castrol Edge East ('Event Special Stage' or 'Super Pass' Viewing Only) First WRC Car In The Stage At: 12.16 and 14.03

How to get there:
Starting from Murwillumbah - Brisbane St
1 Exit Murwillumbah crossing the Tweed River.
2 At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Tweed Valley Way - go 1.3km
3 Sharp right at Reserve Creek Rd - go 10.3km
4 Turn left to stay on Reserve Creek Rd - go 2.0km

Arriving at Reserve Creek Rd
Total: 14.5km - about 27 mins

Comment: Rally cars will be heard well before they appear from the forest and negotiate a tricky dirt to bitumen to dirt right hand bend. Spectator area is small so enthusiasts should get in position early, a paddock walk uphill of approximately 230 metres will need to be made to gain access to the viewing point.

Saturday Special Stage Spectator Zone Available Special Stage Spectator Points - Morning Session

Special Stage 16 Dayco North First WRC Car In The Stage At: 07.28

How to get there:
Starting from Summerland Way
1 Head south on Summerland Way toward Lynches Creek Rd - go 0.1km
2 Turn left at Lynches Creek Rd - go 6.2km
Arriving at Lynches Creek Rd
Total: 6.3km - about 13 minutes

NOTE: A shuttle bus service will operate for Dayco North from Wiangaree to the viewing point. Shuttle fees additional.

Comment: Positioned 50 metres above the course, the rally cars approach on a tight gravel road negotiating a right hand turn on a short strip of bitumen to gravel on the corner - a great view for 1km.

SPECIAL NOTE

The Spectator Point formerly identified as Dayco South has been removed from the final spectator itinerary as it failed to meet all of Rally Australia's spectator point criteria.

Please note however that there are still three other exciting points available for Saturday Sept 5 and the facilities at these three points will be outstanding.

Saturday evening sees the final running of the Tweed Super Special Stage in Murwillumbah.

Special Stage 17 Bosch First WRC Car In The Stage At: 08.13

How to get there:
Starting from Kyogle - Summerland Way
1 Head north on Summerland Way - go 6.8km
2 Turn left into Baileys Bridge Rd - go 5.1km

Use CAUTION on the narrow single lane bridge.

Arriving at Wiangaree Rd
Total: 10.1km - about 20 minutes

Comment: Rally cars are in view for 200 metres before negotiating this high speed turn right corner and are then in view for a further 100 metres.

Viewing is not restricted by bushland and the point provides good viewing with an amphitheatre slope on the western side.

Saturday Available Special Stage Spectator Points - Afternoon Session

Special Stage 21 CTEK West First WRC Car In The Stage At: 14.34

* Disabled 'Wheelchair Only' viewing point.
How to get there:
Starting Kyogle - Summerland Way
1 Head south on Summerland Way toward Wiangaree St - go 6.8km
2 Turn left at Hillyard Rd - go 0.1km
3 Continue on Hillyard Rd - go 1.4km
Total: 8.6km - about 11 mins

Starting At Casino
1 Head north on Centre St toward Canterbury St go 0.6km
2 At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Summerland Way go 23.3km
3 Turn right at Hillyard Rd go 0.1km
4 Continue on Hillyard Rd go 1.4km
Total: 25.6km - about 27 mins

Starting from Lismore
1 Casino St - go 2.4km
2 Continue on Bentley Rd - go 32.5km
3 Turn right at Summerland Way - go 0.3km
4 Turn right at Hillyard Rd - go 0.1km
5 Continue on Hillyard Rd - go 1.4km
Total: 37km - about 40 mins

NOTE: It will be necessary for those attending this point to traverse a paddock with a slight incline at the end for approximately 200 metres to reach the viewing area.

Comment: This is probably the best special stage viewing spot of the rally. Rally cars are in sight for 2km from this point as they approach you before negotiating this high speed hairpin corner.

Hwy - go 2.5km
2 Turn right at Sextonville Rd - go 4.4km
3 Turn left at Old Dyraba Rd - go
12.2km
4 Turn left to stay on Old Dyraba Rd
- go 1.2km
5 Turn left at Lower Dyraba Creek Rd
- go 2.4km
6 Turn right at Dyraba Rd - go 2.5km
7 Turn right at Trentys Ln - go 1.9km
8 Slight right at Dyraba Rd - go 21km
Arriving at Dyraba Rd

Total: 28.1km - about 1 hour

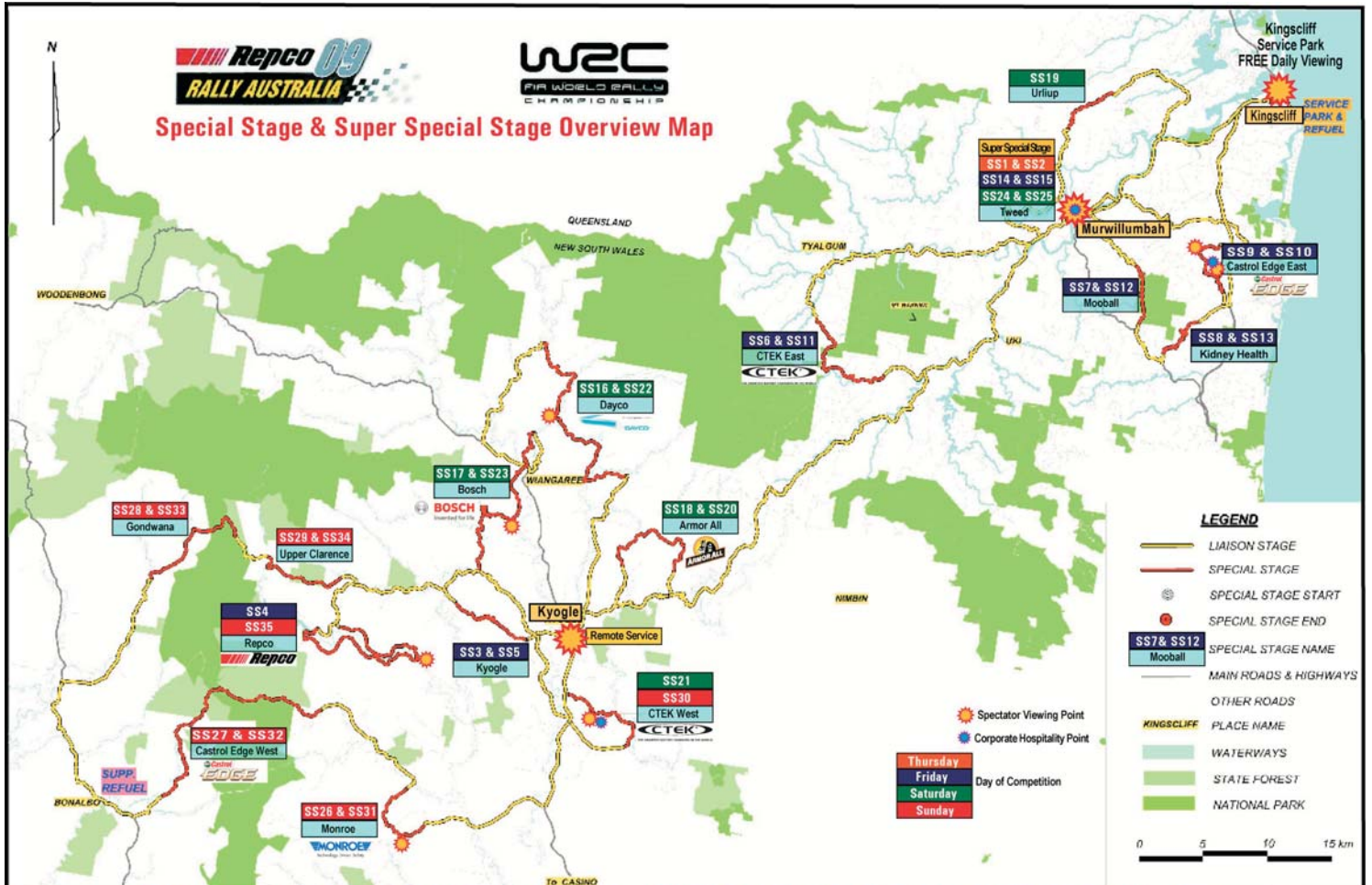
Kingscliff Service Park
